
Welcome to the Czech Senior Open 2026 in Czechia!

FORMAT

Men's and Women's Singles, Men's and Women's Doubles and Mixed Doubles. The tournament will be played in the age groups 35+, 40+, 45+, 50+, 55+, 60+, 65+, 70+, 75+.

Each discipline will start with a group stage of 3, with the group winners advancing to the knockout stage.

**If an event in any age group has less than four players or pairs entered, the organiser may cancel that event and merge the entered players with an event of a younger age group.*

ELIGIBLE PLAYERS

All badminton players who are eligible to play for BWF Members.

A player is eligible to compete, provided he or she fulfils the age requirement before 1 January of the year in which the Championships are played. The referee shall have the power to check the player's age at any time.
